**Are you entitled to a grant to cover the cost of a BRAND NEW COMPUTER?**

Do you have a child in Years 3 to 9? Are you on a low income? (eg getting free school meals or on a benefit?) If so, try applying for a grant for a new computer with internet access from the new 'Home Access' scheme.  
 Home Access is the government programme which will help to ensure that more children in state-maintained education in England have access to technology at home to support learning. Under the programme low-income families who met set eligibility criteria can apply for a Home Access Grant to purchase a compliant Home Access computer and internet package from a range of approved suppliers.
